Fr. Pat Collins CM is a well-known speaker, broadcaster and author. His main interest is the nature of the new evangelisation called for by recent popes. He is a founder member of the New Springtime Community which is devoted to evangelising and training evangelisers.



New Springtime Online School of Evangelisation

In May 2009 a number of men and women in Dublin were led by the Spirit to form a community. They were inspired to name it *New Springtime* and to choose the buttercup as their logo. In 2011 the members agreed that they would commit their energies primarily, though not exclusively, to one or other of three interconnected streams; Evangelising; Formation and Intercessory Prayer.

During the lockdown in 2020, which was a result of the coronavirus pandemic, the members of the New Springtime Community began to see that there was a silver lining to the dark cloud of difficulty. We discovered that if we used modern means of communication, such as Zoom, we could realise our dream of establishing an online school of evangelisation. We felt that we could fulfil our desire of reaching people all over Ireland and even further afield in a way that would not have been possible in the past.

To begin with, we are happy to announce the launch of the following online courses in the immediate future:



(1) FORMATION FOR EVANGELISATION



This is our foundational certificate course, consisting of 26 sessions, 13 before Christmas 2020, and 13 after. It will begin with a prayer, followed by the input, after which there will be small group sharing - guidelines will be available - followed by general group reactions and the closing prayer.

- There will be no entrance requirements, written work or exams.



(2) **HEALING & THE NEW EVANGELISATION**



Pope Benedict XVI, has observed in his book, Jesus of Nazareth, that "Healing is an essential dimension of the apostolic mission and of the Christian faith in general. It can even be said that Christianity is a 'therapeutic religion, a religion of healing." This certificate course will examine how healing is an essential aspect of integral evangelisation. This course will consist of 20 sessions, 13 before Christmas 2020, and 7afterwards.

LIFE IN THE SPIRIT SEMINARS



On June 12th 2015, Pope Francis spoke about the Life in the Spirit Seminars which prepare people to receive the baptism in the Holy Spirit, when he said to priests and religious,

"I ask all of you, each of you, that as part of the stream of grace of the Charismatic Renewal to organise seminars of Life in the Spirit, in your parishes, in your seminaries and schools ... share your teaching on the Baptism of the Spirit, because it is produced by the work of the Holy Spirit through a personal encounter with Jesus. which changes lives."

In a speech on June 8th 2019 to 4,500 members of the Catholic Charismatic Renewal in Rome Pope Francis said,

"What does the Pope expect of you? I expect this movement to share Baptism in the Spirit with everyone in the Church. It is the grace you have received. Share it!"

In response to the Pope's urging we will conduct two seven-week *Life in the Spirit Seminars* during the coming year and a webinar day on *Baptism in the Spirit*.



Webinar on Baptism in the Spirit

In the first term we will have a webinar on the subject of "Baptism in the Spirit in Catholic teaching." It will consist of three inputs by Fr. Pat Collins CM on Saturday, September 19th. There will be two sessions on the theology of Baptism in the Spirit, and one on how to run the Life in the Spirit Seminars when the Coronavirus restrictions end.
